DRUMGOFF WALK

24 Minute drive from Hotel - Parking at Drumgoff Forest Car Park



This route provides several access options to the open mountains below Carrawaystick Mountain. The route can also be started or finished at two of the upper car parks. The entrance to the lower car park can be found on the right after the bridge after passing the junction beside Glenmalure Lodge. This site has a small trail head and access point to the mountains to the west – Carrawaystick and Cloghernagh

and the main summit of Lugnaquillia Mountain.

It is possible to access the Wicklow Way at this point and go north to Drumgoff Cross Roads or south towards the Iron Bridge.

The Mountain Access Route gives access to the remote area of Carrawaystick Mountain and Kelly's Lough.

Grade: Moderate, marked with White markers Distance: 2 km Estimated time: 1hrs Total height climbed: 400m Highest point: 500m Terrain underfoot: Forest trail Suitable for: Fit walkers

Notes: The network of forest roads in this area can be difficult to navigate, remain on marked trails. If you access the open mountains you must be properly equipped and be able to navigate in difficult conditions.
